This training is not a certification training (APSA inspections, STI or API tank inspections).

The training provides detailed information about tanks and information for inspectors to utilize when conducting APSA inspections, including:

- Tank System Components, Functions and Testing (AST System Anatomy)
- Tank Construction Standards Review (API, UL, and SWRI)
- Industry Inspection Standards Review (STI SP001)
- Interpreting SP001 Certified Inspection Reports
- USTs as ASTs-How to Identify, and Actions to be Taken
- How Bad is Bad? Corrosion, Leaks, and Containment Issues
- Field Erected Tanks

*It is recommended that students bring Steel Tank Institute (STI) SP001 and Petroleum Equipment Institute (PEI) Recommended Practice RP200. These industry standards are integral to the training.

12 REHS Contact hours are available. You must attend both days, sign in and out (show up on-time after lunch) and complete an evaluation to get REHS credit. After your evaluation has been completed, your certificate will be posted to your member account. Partial credit is not provided.

Each jurisdiction may send up to 4 people at no charge.
