SPoo1 Standard for the Inspection of Aboveground Storage Tanks

- First edition released in 2000
- 6th edition released in 2018
- Reviewed every five years



SP001/SP031 Standards Committee

- Committee formed in August 2022:
 - 8 Shop Fabricated Tank Manufacturers
 - 8 Regulators
 - 6 Owners
 - 2 Component Manufacturers
 - 6 Consultants



SP001/SP031 Standards Committee

- Public comments were accepted until October 21, 2022
 - SPoo1: 52 comments received
 - SPo31: 16 comments received
- Held monthly meetings since November to discuss comments
- Updated standards to be published in 2023



SPoo1 Standard for the Inspection of Aboveground Storage Tanks

- Updated references:
 - i.e. Change MSDS to SDS
 - i.e. Change NACE to AMPP
- Add manway and gauge to the list in section 1.3.5 of SP001 standard
- Revise table 5.5 and definition of portable container to show possible materials of construction for portable container



SPoo1 Standard for the Inspection of Aboveground Storage Tanks

- Update all references to "DT" or "DPT" to Penetrant Testing (PT)
- Clarify jacketed tank or insulated tank is not equivalent to double wall
- Update certain figures with additional labeling
- If testing methods that are capable of complete floor coverage are not practical, use equipment that tests individual points



Assigned Work Groups

- ASTs which store liquids with a specific gravity greater than 1
- Monitoring for water in a tank and interstice
- Microbiologically influenced corrosion
- Review of periodic inspection questions for wide applicability and clarity of questions



SP031 Standard for Repair of Shop Fabricated Aboveground Tanks

- Protect integrity of tank labeling during repairs or maintenance activity
- Personnel qualified per Authority Having Jurisdiction requirements
- Update certain figures




