Information Follow-Up Request

- CUPA received evaluation notification
 - Uploads files to SharePoint within 60 days
- After CUPA uploads to SharePoint:
 - CalEPA notifies evaluators
 - Evaluators review Enclosure 1 and 2
 - Missing files provided to CalEPA lead
 - CalEPA sends follow-up request to CUPA
 - Upload cycle resumes
- If files are still missing, the lead evaluator will reach out to the CUPA contact directly

Deficiencies

- Not documenting return to compliance within 60 days for testing and leak detection failures
- Not ensuring single-walled UST related information in CERS is accurate and complete
