




"Subpart P States" - Inspections



March 20 - 23, 2023

Registration/Notification

- One-time notification that we are a healthcare facility (HCF) operating under 266 Subpart
 P within 60 days of rule's effective date
- Maintain notification on file (readily available during inspections)

"Does Not Sewer Hazardous Waste Pharmaceuticals"



Do not rinse or dispose of hazardous waste or pharmaceuticals down the drain.

These items include:

- · Prescription medications
- Over-the-counter drugs
- · Items containing residual pharmaceuticals
- · Controlled substances
- Residues of pharmaceuticals remaining in empty containers
- · Potentially hazardous materials

The location of a spill kit is listed on your EPP Summary.

Locate resources and support

Ensures that all personnel that mange non-creditable HWP are thoroughly familiar with proper waste handling and emergency procedures relevant to their responsibilities during normal facility operations and emergencies











CONTAINER MANAGEMENT

- Are NC HWPs placed in containers that are structurally sound, compatible with the contents, and that lack evidence of leakage, spillage, or damage that could cause leakage under reasonably foreseeable conditions?
- Are containers of NC HWPS closed and secured in a manner that prevents unauthorized access to the contents?
- Are containers labeled or clearly marked with the phrase "Hazardous Waste Pharmaceuticals?"
- Are containers accumulated on-site for one year or less?

MANIFEST REQUIREMENTS

- Are all NC HWPs shipped off-site accompanied by a manifest (U.S. EPA Form 8700-22)?
- Does each manifest designate at least one facility which is permitted to handle the waste?
- Have the manifests been signed by the generator and initial transporter?
- Are signed copies of manifests being retained for at least three years?
- Has the healthcare facility complied with land disposal restriction requirements?
- If the healthcare facility did not receive a copy of the manifest with the signature of the owner or operator of the designated facility within 60 days after being accepted by the transporter, did the healthcare facility submit an exception report?
- Are signed copies of exception reports being maintained for at least three years?

Pharmaceutical Spill Cleanup Materials

When handling a pharmaceutical spill cleanup, contact the

CVS Health Safety Hotline at 888-464-2960

- The spill is larger than you typically handle, or;
- You require assistance on the proper safety/protective equipment to wear.

NEVER place spill cleanup materials in the trash or rinse down the drain.

Spill cleanup supplies are available in the Hazardous Waste collection area.

> Note: Additional spill cleanup materials are available at spill stations on the sales floor for CVS Pharmacy in Target locations.

- Place all cleanup materials used to handle the spill in a hazardous waste bag.
- For a liquid pharmaceutical spill, place sufficient absorbent to completely soak up all liquids in the bag if the liquid is not selfcontained.
- Seal the hazardous waste bag completely.
 - Place the sealed hazardous waste bag containing liquids in a second hazardous waste bag to prevent liquids from leaking.
- Label the bag to clearly identify the pharmaceutical contained inside.
- Place the labeled bag in the Hazardous Waste "PHARMACY" tote.


SPILLS

- Has the healthcare facility immediately contained all spills of NC HWPs and manage the spill clean-up materials as NC HWPs?
- Has the healthcare facility immediately contained all spills of potentially creditable hazardous waste pharmaceuticals and managed the spill cleanup materials as non-creditable hazardous waste pharmaceuticals?

Shipping Potentially Creditable Hazardous Waste Pharmaceuticals

RECORDKEEPING

- Has the healthcare facility retained copies of shipping papers and confirmation of deliveries for all shipments of PC HWPs for at least three years?
- If delivery confirmation is not received within thirtyfive calendar days after the date that the shipment of PC HWPs was sent, did the healthcare facility contact the carrier and the reverse distributor to report delivery confirmation was not received and to determine the status of the PC HWPs?
